

JOINT COMMUNIQUE ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC  
RELATIONS BETWEEN THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF SOMALIA AND  
THE REPUBLIC OF NICARAGUA

The Federal Republic of Somalia and the Republic of Nicaragua, guided by a shared willingness to develop and strengthen the ties of friendship and cooperation between the two countries, have decided to establish diplomatic relations at the level of Non-Resident Ambassadors.

Both parties wish to manifest their confidence that, the establishment of diplomatic relations and the exchange of Ambassadors between the two countries, will contribute to the development of bilateral cooperation and the consolidation of world peace.

The Federal Republic of Somalia and the Republic of Nicaragua reaffirm their will to build their bilateral relationship in accordance with the Charter of the United Nations and International Law, including the principles of peaceful coexistence, equality, mutual respect for the principles of sovereignty, territorial integrity, and the non-interference in the internal affairs of the States.

Done and signed in New York, on the 27 day of September, two thousand and twenty-four (2024), in two originals in English and Spanish, both being equally authentic.
